



Abstract

Collegiate Education – Tamil Nadu Collegiate Educational Services – 314 Lecturers appointed on contract basis during 1986-1993 in Government Arts and Science Colleges and Colleges of Education and paid on regular time scale of pay – Service rendered - taken into account for calculation of pensionary benefits only - orders – Issued.

ORDER

During the year 1986-1993, 314 Lecturers were appointed on contract basis in Government Arts and Science Colleges and Colleges of Education under Collegiate Educational Service through the proceeding of the Director of Collegiate Education on a regular time scale of pay.

2. In Government order first read above, the Government had instructed the Teachers Recruitment Board to conduct interview for the M.Phil and Ph.D degree holder and to conduct written test and interview for the other candidates who were not M.Phil and Ph.D., degree holder so as to bring them into regular service.

3. In Government order second read above, orders were issued for the appointment of all the 314 contract lecturers working in Government Colleges on regular basis with effect from 26.3.1993 based on the marks obtained by them during the interview held by the Teachers Recruitment Board and by adopting rule of reservation.

4. In Government order third read above, orders were issued regularising the services of the above 314 contract lecturers from 26.03.1993 (i.e.) from the date on which they were regularly appointed as Lecturers.

5. In Government order fourth read above, orders were issued for counting the services rendered by the above 314 Lecturers on contract basis by condoning break-in-service for career advancement, subject to certain conditions.

6. In letter fifth read above, the General Secretary, Tamil Nadu Government College Teachers Association in his representation dated 7.6.2012 has stated that as per rule 11(1) of the Tamil Nadu Pension Rules 1978, the service rendered on contract basis is eligible for pension purpose and requested to count the contract service period for pensionary benefits like the contract period taken into account for career advancement.

7. The Director of Collegiate Education in his letter sixth read above has stated that the contract lecturers were paid in the regular scale of pay i.e.Rs.2200-75-2800-100-4000 under relevant Head of Accounts from 1986 to 1993. They were involved in whole time employment and they have worked in a post of Lecturer for which regular posts have been sanctioned and they were paid salary on monthly basis. The Director of Collegiate Education, Chennai has also requested the Government to count the period of services rendered from 1986 to 1993 by the Lecturers for the pensionary benefits.

8. The Government have examined the request of the Tamil Nadu Government College Teachers Association carefully in the light of the report of Director of Collegiate Education and decided to count the service of Lecturers rendered on contract basis for pensionary benefits. Accordingly, Government hereby allow to count the service rendered by 314 lecturers appointed on contract basis, for the period from 23.6.1986 to 25.3.1993 along with regular service in Government Arts and Science Colleges and Colleges of Education under Tamil Nadu Collegiate Educational Services, as qualifying service for pensionary benefits only as per Rule 11(1) of the Tamil Nadu Pension Rules 1978, subject to the condition that the break in service and non-salary period shall not be taken into account for qualifying service.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.65964/Finance(Pen)/2014, dated 4.12.2014.
